Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for your patience and understanding during these challenging times. With the Governor calling for schools to remain closed until the end of the school year, we have been working on ways to communicate and provide resources for our WESD families. Today, we have updates regarding state and local resources for families, report cards, StudentVUE access and packet pick up reminder.

### **Resources for Families**

We know that many of our families are hurting during these challenging times. The Web site, **[arizonatogether.org](http://arizonatogether.org)**, provides many resources for families including mental health, employment, financial assistance, community resources and options for Internet access, to name a few. The Web site, **[211arizona.org](http://211arizona.org)** also provides resources for families including clothing, housing, health and dental, support groups and family services. The WESD Social Services Department, including school social workers, are available remotely through email and will be checking voicemail regularly.

### **Third Quarter Report Cards**

Report cards for the third quarter will be mailed to all students on Friday. Please be sure to watch for it in your mail the week of April 6. If you do not receive a report card, please email your child's teacher or your school's principal. Emails for all teachers and principals are accessible on school Web sites. ### **StudentVUE Access**

StudentVUE is an additional online service that gives students additional ways to communicate and stay informed. Students have access to school-related information, such as assignments, via a secure web site. Every WESD student has a StudentVUE account. Your child's user name is his or her student ID number. If he or she can't remember the student ID number, it can be located on the report card that you should receive next week. If your child does not remember how to log on, we've provided guidance below. If you need help accessing StudentVUE, please email your child's teacher.
