We have been receiving questions regarding the completion of the school year. We have attempted to answer the most frequently asked questions. If your question is not answered, please contact the District Office at 602-347-2657.

1. **Will the students’ school year be extended?**

No. The last day of school will remain Tuesday, May 22. To make-up for lost instruction, Wednesday, May 9 and May 16 will be FULL DAYS.

2. **Will eighth grade promotion dates remain the same?**

Yes. There will be no changes to the dates and times of eighth grade promotions at any of our 7/8 or K-8 schools.

3. **Will special events that were cancelled at my school during the closure be rescheduled?**

That will be up to each school to determine if there is sufficient time to reschedule the event.

4. **Will there be summer school/summer programming?**

Yes. Summer school will begin as scheduled on Tuesday, May 29, as will the Gifted Summer Program and various enrichment classes. KidSpace summer childcare will begin Wednesday, May 23. Extended School Year (ESY) summer school will begin Monday, June 4.
