You decide where your money goes!

hen you make a school tax credit donation you are enhancing the education of a child. Your donation can go to the program you specify, or you may permit the school to designate which of its extracurricular programs your donation will support. You do not need to have a child enrolled in school to make a tax credit donation.

As a taxpayer, Arizona Revised Statute §43-1089.01 allows you to reduce your personal state income tax bill. It's a win-win situation! For example, if you owe \$650 in state income taxes and you donate \$200 to a WESD school, you may subtract \$200 from the total taxes owed. The actual income tax you owe would be \$450. Check with your personal tax consultant to see if you are also eligible for a deduction on your federal taxes.

State Department of Revenue Guidelines

- The tax credit program gives a dollar-for-dollar reduction in state income taxes. **The credit is \$400 for married taxpayers who file a joint return and \$200 for single taxpayers or heads of households.** If married taxpayers file separate returns, each spouse may claim one-half of the credit that would have been allowed.
- Public education tax credits may only be used to the extent that they reduce a tax liability to zero. Any unused amounts may be carried forward for not more than five consecutive years.
- You do not need to have a child enrolled in a school to take advantage of this tax credit.
- If a program is not designated by the contributor, the school will choose a program based on greatest need.
- Checks must be made payable to the individual school of the taxpayer's choice.
- > Tax credit donations must be made on or before April 15 to be applied to the prior year's taxes.
- When the school receives the check, a receipt will be issued for the individual's tax record. The District will also submit notification to the Arizona Department of Revenue.
