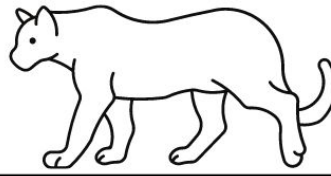


Orangewood School 5th Grade Newsletter

Language Arts

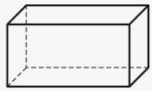
Social Studies
