It is hard to believe, but we will be heading into the 4th quarter of the 2022-2023 school year right after spring break! We are planning to finish the year strong!

The state testing window is quickly approaching for our 3-8 grade students. Students in grades 5 and 8 will be taking the AZSci Testing and students in grades 3-8 will be taking the Arizona Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) Testing. It is important that students arrive on time on testing days as we try to get started right after breakfast. Be sure your child is well-rested. Look ahead and be certain to schedule any appointments needed on days that will not interfere with testing days.

If you would like to send a snack with your child for testing days, you are welcome to do so. Below is the schedule for the state tests coming up the end of March and for the first few weeks in April. State testing allows us to see how much students have learned and their growth this year. We want students to feel confident in taking the test. All we ask is for students to try hard and do their very best!
