### Help us to help others!


The school Food Drive starts on Monday, April 24, and ends on Friday, May 5, at 3:45 p.m.

Students in incoming grades 3 through 8 should save at least one cereal box and two magazines with lots of pictures for art class next year.






## **Guild News**
