




Lead in our Social Etiquette

- Speak in a pleasant tone of voice




Lead during Arrival and Dismissal

- Use positive respectful language




Lead in the Hallway

- Space in front and behind




Lead entering the Classroom

- Begin immediately on "do now" work




Lead in Learning Spaces

- Be prepared to learn




Lead in Our Technology




- Carry Chromebook with two hands

- Report problems to adult




Lead in the Cafeteria



- Walk and wait quietly in line

- Sit at assigned table
- Use indoor voices
- Keep your hands, feet and other objects to yourself
- When finished clean up your area of the table
- Sit quietly and wait to be dismissed by an adult to throw away trash


Lead on the Playground

- Walking until you get to the playground area
- Keep your hands, feet and other objects to yourself
- Think Win-Win and Synergize: include others and take turns
- Only slide down the slides
- Line up when the whistle blows




Lead on the Merry-Go-Round

- Only four students may ride at a time
- Two students are allowed to push it
- When the Merry-Go-Round starts, students are allowed 60 seconds to ride. After that, they must get off and allow the next group of students that are waiting to get on.




Lead on the Swings

- One person at a time on the swing
- Swing properly back and forth
- Next in line for the swing waits outside the wood chips
- Jumping off swings is not allowed
- Next In line counts 60 full swings out loud




Lead in Our Attire (Grades K-5)

- Clothing must not interfere with learning or safety
- Pajamas and slippers are not allowed, unless it is a spirit day
- Clothing must cover undergarments at all times
- Sneakers are recommended (required on PE days)
- Hats, caps, hoodies and bandannas shall not be worn indoors



Lead in Our Attire (Grades 6-8)



- Clothing must not interfere with learning or safety
- Pajamas and slippers are not allowed, unless it is a spirit day
- Sneakers are recommended (required on PE days)
- Pants must fit on the waist and no undergarments should be visible
- Clothing must cover undergarments at all times
- Clothing such as see-through or fish-net fabrics, spaghetti straps, halter tops, low-cut tops, bare midriff tops that show the belly button when arms are raised above the head, hiphugger pants that are too low and excessively short shorts or skirts are prohibited.
- Hats, caps, hoodies and bandannas shall not be worn indoors
