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Principal's Message— Every Student Deserves a Team!

With testing wrapped up, teachers are jumping back into their lessons that will be a combination of review, new skills and even a preview of skills that students will see next year. This time of year is very busy for both families, students and staff. Graduations, promotions and other end-of-the-year celebrations are taking place. Please remind your students that attendance is still a priority and that their best efforts are needed inside and outside the classroom.

I pulled our data on fights and physical altercations and compared to where we are at this year compared to last year. We have reduced the number of fights/physical altercations by 53%. This is huge and I know we are making strides in the right direction to create a safe and fun environment for our middle schoolers. We all need to look out for each other and do our part by reporting our concerns directly to the school and police if necessary.

Please discuss with your child the importance of being kind and not pointing out differences that students have. A reminder that bullying is also a repeated occurrence by the same individual or group over time. It is not a single event or isolated event. It is important to report the isolated events in the case it continues. We then have the documentation to follow the bullying protocol which goes beyond just an isolated event. Encourage your child that when they see someone who looks or dresses differently that sometimes ignoring it and not asking questions about why they look a certain way is the kinder approach. Even as adults we do not always realize that our curiosity and questions may come across as rude or hurtful.
