You decide where your money goes!

hen you make a school tax credit donation you are enhancing the education of a child. Your donation can go to the program you specify, or you may permit the school to designate which of its extracurricular programs your donation will support. You do not need to have a child enrolled in school to make a tax credit donation.

As a taxpayer, Arizona Revised Statute §43-1089.01 allows you to reduce your personal state income tax bill. It's a win-win situation! For example, if you owe \$650 in state income taxes and you donate \$200 to a WESD school, you may subtract \$200 from the total taxes owed. The actual income tax you owe would be \$450. Check with your personal tax consultant to see if you are also eligible for a deduction on your federal taxes.

NOTES FROM OUR HEALTH OFFICE

- **All letters have been sent home notifying parents/guardians if your child did not pass vision and/or hearing screenings at school. It is important to follow up with your child's health care provider if your child did not pass a vision and/or hearing screening. If they are having difficulty seeing or hearing, it will affect their ability to be successful in the classroom. Please provide any documentation from your child's physician to the health office. The WESD has a full-time audiologist available for more in-depth hearing testing, free of charge. To schedule an appointment, please contact the health office. If you have any questions regarding your child's vision and/or hearing screening, please contact the health office.
- ** Maricopa County Dental Sealant Program provides dental screenings to second and sixth grade students. We will schedule a screening day here at Cactus Wren and consent forms will be sent home soon. Please return the forms to the health office as soon as possible. If your child is on AHCCCS, they are eligible to receive FREE sealants. Any student that returns a consent form will receive a coupon for a free personal size pizza at Peter Piper Pizza!
- **Please do not send <u>any</u> medication to school with your child. All medication needs to be brought to the health office by a parent or guardian. This includes cough drops, ointments, creams and sunscreen. The only medication that can be administered to your child is the medication you supply.
- ** If your child has a need to change clothes during the school day and they go home in borrowed clothes, please return those clothes to the health office. There is no need to wash them as they will be washed in the health office when they are returned.
