#### New Employee Placement Guidelines

1. Up to ten (10) years of prior certified contracted experience may be granted at 2% per year based on the minimum base contract amount.
2. Education credit is awarded for college coursework completed after initial Bachelor's Degree is conferred. Credit must be completed at an accredited institution. Transcripts are required for verification.
3. Work Calendar is 208 Days, which includes 185 working days for Social Workers.
4. Work Calendar is 227 Days, which includes 203 working days for Lead Social Worker.
