The WESD print shop does not encourage bringing in their own shirts as it cannot be held responsible for replacing shirts if something goes wrong in the printing process, and the cost structure is different.

Logistics...

- If a group is interested in ordering shirts, the order is entered into our system as one group order.
- That means one committee member would need to gather all the details (names, sizes, shirt colors, etc.) into a single spreadsheet.
- The order would be placed under that person's name, and that member would be responsible for collecting the funds and distributing the shirts.
- This is the same process schools use—one person collects payment from their group and then pays with one credit card or other approved payment method.
- Payments can be paid using credit cards, check, or money order. Cash is not an option.
